4.	<p><b><u>Presentation – Richard Daniels</u></b></p> <p>To mark the retirement of Richard Daniels the long serving Parish Clerk/Treasurer, the former Chairman Brian Lewis was invited to say a few words of appreciation. Richard was then formally presented with a card and gift voucher to acknowledge the gratitude of the current councillors for his services to Maltby. 6.	<p><b><u>Report of the Village Hall Committee</u></b></p> <p>Councillor Mrs.A.P.Smith, Chairperson of the Village Hall provided an update.</p> <p>The committee held a meeting on 22nd October 2013 at which progress on the grant applications was given. The grant for a printer and ancilliary equipment had been submitted but further information for the kitchen equipment and solar panelling is still awaited. The committee are to seek marketing advice and assistance with setting up a website. A music evening was held on 14<sup>th</sup> September 2103 which raised £460 for village hall funds with a raffle held in aid of Zoe's Place raising £243. A wine tasting event was held on 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2013 which raised money for the village hall and a raffle in aid of Marie Curie. The Annual Maltby Road Race took place on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2013 with the Village Hall Committee members providing drinks and light refreshments to runners and supporters which was likely to raise in the region of a further £100 once all accounts have been finalised."</p>	Noted
7.	<p><b><u>Planning Matters</u></b></p> <p>The Application for the erection of a New Dormer Dwelling house and Garage at Reivaulx High Lane Maltby had been rejected by Stockton on Tees Borough Council and the Council are unaware of any appeal to this application The Government's Minister has now given approval to the Planning application at Low Lane High Leven Yarm to erect The Ingleby Manor Free School and 6<sup>th</sup> Form and Residential Development of 350 houses including a means of access. It was reported that a Scoping Application for a further 550 houses adjoining this site has been submitted. The District Councillor present agreed to keep the Parish Council aware of progress with this further Application</p>	JK
